#### **NEW JERSEY ANNOUNCES NEW SCIENCE ASSESSMENT**

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) has altered the statewide science assessment previous known as the NJASK Science. In past years, the NJASK Science was taken in the month of May during a student's fourth and eighth grade school year. This year, the NJDOE created a new science assessment, named the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment-Science (NJSLA-S). In November 2017, the State Board of Education proposed a change that would require students in grade 5 to be assessed in order to align the assessment to the state's new elementary science standards. Therefore, grade 4 students will no longer take the state science assessment. The NJSLA-S will be a computerized assessment taken on the same computer-based testing platform as PARCC. Similar to the statewide PARCC assessment, the NJSLA-S will be administered during the month of May. Students in grade five and eight will complete the NJSLA-S on May 29, 2018 and May 30, 2018. Please refer to the table below that indicates the number of minutes spent on each of the four science units.

#### **CONFERENCES: DECEMBER 11 - 14**

Over the past several years, parents have shared their concerns regarding Parent/Teacher conferences for students in Grade 6-8. Specifically, parents have indicated they would prefer to meet with the teacher(s) of the subject(s) they are having difficulty instead of the randomness of meeting with their child's period 2 teacher. In addition, parents of students doing well in all subjects would have preferred no conference at all.

Therefore, this year, Grade 6-8 Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held on an "as-needed" basis for students in Grades 6-8 that have been identified by their teachers as needing a conference to discuss academic and/or behavioral concerns. Parents of students who are not identified as needing a conference may contact their child's guidance counselor at any time during the year to schedule a teacher meeting or may request to be on a waiting list should conference times allow.

Grade 5 conferences will remain student-led with each parent and student having a conference.

All Special Area teachers will be available in the cafeteria for any parent that is interested in discussing content pertinent to their class.

#### TRANSPORTATION INFORMTION

Any student needing to ride home or walk home with another student (in an emergency daycare situation only) must:
