## **CONFERENCES**

This year, Parent/Teacher conferences will be in November leading up to Thanksgiving Break. We are continuing our conference process of having Grade 6-8 Parent/Teacher Conferences for only those students that are identified by their teachers as needing a conference to discuss either an academic and/or behavioral concern. Parents of students who are not identified as needing a conference can contact their child's guidance counselor at any time during the year to schedule a teacher meeting OR may request to be on a waiting list should conference times allow.

Due to the transition to Middle School, each fifth grade parent will have an opportunity to conference with their child's Homeroom teacher. Parents who did not provide their email at Back-to-School Night should contact our main office at 848-1200. Emails will be used to allow the teacher to email an invitation to schedule a conference.

## STAYING CONNECTED AT WDMS

Please register for a PowerParent account in the main office, if you do not have a PowerParent login. Also, our school website is a great resource to help you stay up-to-date. Almost every piece of vital information, from either the staff or main office, is posted on the WDMS website. It is important to stay on top of your student's grades, attendance, and school events. In addition, you can stay connected with WDMS via our Official Facebook and Twitter pages. The majority of WDMS correspondence will be done through the School Messenger Notification System. Please make every effort to alert our main office immediately with any email or phone number changes. Incorrect information will delay the ability to receive important information from the WDMS staff. If you are not receiving our School Messenger text and email notifications, please contact the main office at 848-1200.

## STUDENT DROP OFF/PICK-UP

The school day for students officially begins at 7:45am. Students must be in homeroom by 7:55 am or they will be marked late. For your convenience, the doors will be open at 7:25am for students that wish to arrive early. These students will report directly to the cafeteria until 7:45am. Any student arriving before 7:25am will be left unsupervised and outside (in possible inclement weather) until 7:25am.

Although we realize emergencies do occur, if you know in advanced that you will need to pick your child up early, we ask that a note be sent in with your child the morning of the day he/she will be leaving early. Your child will then be given a pass to show his/her teacher at the indicated dismissal time. Without the parent note informing us of an early pick-up, no students will be called out of class until the parent arrives in the main office and proof of identification has been given. A parent phone call requesting the student to meet them in the main office for pick-up is not an option.

## Q1 Interim Reports

Your child's Quarter 1 interim will conclude on October 3· Please refer to your email to receive an electronic copy on October 7· The interim report will provide students and parents with an indication of their child's mid-marking period progress in each of their courses. If you should have any questions regarding your child's grade or academic progress, please contact their teacher or school counselor.

## TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

No child will be permitted to ride on other buses for any reason. Each student can only ride the bus they are assigned to ride. If you have a one-day childcare issue, the person watching your child should pick them up at the school. No students will be permitted to switch between buses.

Students will NOT be given permission by WDMS administration to walk to any other location except home. (i.e. ice cream stand, pizza place or a friend's house).

Late buses are every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Late buses depart at 3:45pm. Late bus runs are typically longer as there are only five late buses covering a larger area. Students may not stay after school unless a teacher supervises them. If attending a sporting event as a spectator, students must leave and return at the beginning of the event.
